

Privacy Policy

This Privacy Policy explains how VaultNote - Private Notes (“VaultNote,” “we,” “us,” or “our”) handles information when you use our mobile application.

VaultNote is designed as a local private notes and file vault app. You can create private notes, checklists, attach selected media, take photos, record videos, record voice memos, and save related private records on your device.

1. No Account, No Login

VaultNote does not require account registration or login.

We do not ask you to create an account, provide a username, password, phone number, or email address in order to use the app.

2. No Third-Party SDKs

VaultNote 1.0 does not use third-party analytics SDKs, advertising SDKs, crash reporting SDKs, subscription SDKs, or third-party login services.

We do not share your notes, recordings, photos, videos, or private files with third-party services.

3. No Tracking

VaultNote 1.0 does not use App Tracking Transparency.

We do not request tracking permission.

We do not access the advertising identifier.

We do not track you across apps or websites owned by other companies.

VaultNote 1.0 does not include subscriptions or in-app purchases.

We do not collect payment information.

We do not process purchases.

We do not receive billing information from Apple.

VaultNote stores app content locally on your device. This may include:

- Notes you create

- Checklist items you create

- Photos you take or choose to add

- Videos you record or choose to add

- Voice memos you record

- Files or records you choose to save in the app

- App settings related to local app usage

This content stays on your device unless you choose to export, share, delete, or back it up through your device system settings.

We do not upload your private notes, photos, videos, recordings, or files to our own server.

6. Camera Access

VaultNote may request camera access when you choose to take a photo or record a video inside the app.

Camera access is used only for user-selected actions, such as:

- Taking a photo for a private note

- Recording a video for a private note

- Creating a media attachment for a private record

VaultNote does not use the camera in the background.

7. Microphone Access

VaultNote may request microphone access when you choose to record audio or record a video with sound.

Microphone access is used only for user-selected actions, such as:

- Recording a voice memo

- Recording audio for a note

- Recording sound when capturing a video

VaultNote does not use the microphone in the background.

8. Photo Library Access

If VaultNote allows you to add existing photos or videos from your photo library, the app may request photo library access.

Photo library access is used only so you can select media to add to private notes or local records.

VaultNote does not automatically scan your full photo library.

VaultNote does not upload your photo library to a server.

VaultNote does not use your photos or videos for advertising or tracking.

If VaultNote allows you to add files, the app may open the system file picker so you can choose files from your device.

VaultNote only handles files you choose to add.

10. How We Use App Content

Your local app content is used only to provide app features, such as:

- Creating and editing private notes

- Saving checklist items

- Taking photos for notes

- Recording videos for notes

Recording voice memos

Attaching selected media or files

Displaying saved local records inside the app

Deleting or restoring local notes where supported

We do not use your private content for advertising, analytics, profiling, or third-party data sharing.

11. Data Retention and Deletion

Your notes, recordings, photos, videos, and files remain stored locally on your device until you delete them, delete the app, or remove app data from your device.

If the app includes a Recently Deleted or trash feature, deleted items may remain locally inside that section until you permanently delete them or the app removes them according to the app's local deletion behavior.

If you delete the app, local app data may also be deleted from your device.

12. Device Backup

Depending on your device settings, local app data may be included in your device backup, such as iCloud Backup or computer backup.

VaultNote does not control Apple device backup settings. You can manage backup settings in your device settings.

13. Security

VaultNote is designed to keep your private records local on your device.

However, no storage method is completely secure. You are responsible for protecting your device, device passcode, Apple ID, and app access.

If your device is lost, unlocked, jailbroken, compromised, or accessed by another person, your local app content may be at risk.

14. Children's Privacy

VaultNote is not intended for children under 13.

We do not knowingly collect personal information from children under 13. Because VaultNote 1.0 does not use login, server accounts, or third-party analytics, we do not knowingly collect account-based personal information from children.

15. Your Choices

You can control your data and permissions in the following ways:

Delete notes and records inside the app

Delete local attachments or recordings inside the app where supported

Delete the app to remove local app data from your device

Disable Camera permission in device settings

Disable Microphone permission in device settings

Disable Photo Library permission in device settings

Manage device backup settings in your device settings

If you disable a permission, the related feature may not work until permission is granted again.

16. Support Requests

If you contact us for support, you may voluntarily provide information such as your email address, screenshots, or a description of your issue.

We use support information only to respond to your request.

Please do not send private notes, personal recordings, sensitive photos, videos, or confidential files unless necessary for support.

17. Changes to This Privacy Policy

We may update this Privacy Policy from time to time.

If we make changes, we will update the effective date above. Your continued use of the app after the updated Privacy Policy becomes available means you accept the updated policy.
