

Terms of Use

Effective Date: [6/1/2026]

These Terms of Use (“Terms”) govern your use of VaultNote - Private Notes (“VaultNote,” “the app,” “we,” “us,” or “our”).

By downloading, accessing, or using VaultNote, you agree to these Terms. If you do not agree, do not use the app.

1. App Description

VaultNote is a local private notes and file vault app.

The app allows you to create private notes, checklist notes, take photos, record videos, record voice memos, attach selected media or files, and organize private records locally on your device.

VaultNote 1.0 does not require login, does not include subscriptions, does not include in-app purchases, does not use third-party SDKs, and does not request tracking permission.

2. Local App Content

You are responsible for all content you create, record, import, attach, save, edit, or delete in VaultNote.

This may include:

Notes

Checklists

Photos

Videos

Voice memos

Files

Other local private records

VaultNote stores app content locally on your device.

We do not guarantee that local content can be recovered if you delete the app, reset your device, lose your device, damage your device, remove app data, or change device backup settings.

You should export or back up important content before deleting the app, changing devices, or modifying device storage settings.

3. No Account or Login

VaultNote does not require account registration or login.

Because there is no account system, we cannot recover local app content for you if it is deleted from your device.

4. No Subscription, No In-App Purchase

VaultNote 1.0 does not include subscriptions or in-app purchases.

There are no paid features, auto-renewable subscriptions, free trials, or purchase restoration flows in this version.

5. Permissions

VaultNote may request device permissions only when needed for app features you choose to use.

Camera permission may be requested when you choose to take a photo or record a video.

Microphone permission may be requested when you choose to record a voice memo or record a video with sound.

Photo Library permission may be requested if you choose to add existing photos or videos from your device.

Files access may be used through the system file picker if you choose to add files.

You can manage permissions in your device settings. If you deny a permission, the related feature may not work.

6. Recording Responsibility

When you use photo, video, or audio recording features, you are responsible for complying with all applicable laws and respecting the rights and privacy of others.

Do not record people, conversations, places, or private information without proper permission where required by law.

VaultNote is a personal organization tool and does not provide legal advice about recording laws.

7. Acceptable Use

You agree not to use VaultNote to:

Violate any law or regulation

Store, create, or distribute illegal, harmful, abusive, or infringing content

Violate the privacy, publicity, or intellectual property rights of others

Record others without permission where permission is required

Attempt to reverse engineer, modify, copy, or interfere with the app

Use the app in a way that damages, disables, or disrupts its functionality

Misrepresent your relationship with us or misuse support channels

You retain ownership of the content you create or add to VaultNote.

We do not claim ownership of your notes, checklists, photos, videos, voice memos, files, or local records.

Because VaultNote stores content locally on your device, you are responsible for managing, exporting, backing up, and deleting your own content.

9. Device Backup and Data Loss

Local app data may be affected by your device settings, operating system behavior, storage

settings, or backup settings.

We are not responsible for loss of local content caused by:

App deletion

Device loss or damage

Device reset

Operating system changes

Storage cleanup by the user or system

Failure to back up or export important content

User error

Device security compromise

Third-party software or device issues

Please keep separate backups of important notes, recordings, videos, photos, and files.
